**BEIJING**

BEIJING The Great Wall, Ming Tombs Tian’anmen Square, the Forbidden City.

**The Great Wall** was built 2,000 years ago like a Chinese dragon wriggles among mountains and rivers, is one of the **seven wonders in the world**, with numerous scenery and historic sites to catch your attention. **The Ming Tombs** - During the Ming Dynasty, there were 14 emperors from the Yongle Reign of Zhudi to the Chongzhen Reign of Zhuyoujian. 13 emperors had their tombs built there except Zhuqiuyu (the Jingtai Reign) who was buried at Golden Mountain in the western suburbs of Beijing, hence the name of the Tombs of 13 Ming Emperors.

**Tian'anmen Square** encompasses 44 hectares (108.7acres), 880 metres from north to south and 500 metres from east to west, big enough to hold half a million people. The square has witnessed the Chinese people' struggle against foreign and reactionary rule at home. In 1919,the May 4th Movement broke out in Beijing . Students and residents staged a patriotic demonstration in the square. In1935, students in Beijing launched the December 9th Movement against the Japanese aggression and Chiang the Kai-shek's policy of non-resistance. They held a demonstration in the square. **The Imperial Palace**, also known as the Forbidden City or "Gugong", was the imperial residence and center of the kingdom during the reign of 24 emperors. 14 in the Ming and 10 in the Qing dynasty resided and ruled from this palace for 491 years until Puyi, the last emperor of the Qing dynasty and of China. It is now the largest and best preserved ancient architecture in China.

**XIAN**

Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses, City Wall, the Great Mosque, Tang Dynasty Music and Dance Show. Big Wild Goose Pagoda, Small Wild Goose Pagoda, Xian Museum.

**The Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses** are the most significant archeological excavations of the 20th century. Work is ongoing at this site, which is around 1.5 kilometers east of Emperor Qin Shi Huang's Mausoleum, Lintong County, Shaanxi Province. It is a sight not to be missed by any visitor to China. **Modern Tang Dynasty Music and Dance Show** - The show presented today is a recreation of a traditional entertainment attributable to a great variety of historical records and relics. In 1981, the artists of Xian's Shaanxi Provincial Song & Dance Troupe, inspired by the thriving tourist industry, conceived a series of programs to illustrate on stage the history, culture and artistic heritage of Xian. At that time, the Tang Dynasty Music and Dance Show, as a comprehensive form of art being lost in admiration, promptly came into the sight of the artists.

As the symbol of the old-line Xian, **Big Wild Goose Pagoda** is a well-preserved ancient building and a holy place for Buddhists. It is located in the southern suburb of Xian City, about 4 kilometers (2.49 miles) from the downtown of the city. Standing in the Da Ci'en Temple complex, it attracts numerous visitors for its fame in the Buddhist religion, its simple but appealing style of construction, and its new square in front of the temple. It is rated as a National Key Cultural Relic Preserve as well as an AAAA Tourist Attraction. Located in the Small Wild Goose Pagoda Scenic Area, **Xian Museum** was opened to the public on the World Museum's Day, May 18th, 2007. Not only does it enhance the environment of the nearby ancient building complex but also means that Xian has a large municipal museum at long last. As many as 130,000 fine cultural relics are kept in the museum, most of which were unearthed in the important tombs and the capital sites of the Zhou Dynasty (11th century BC-221 BC), the Qin Dynasty (221 BC-206 BC), the Han Dynasty (206 BC-220 AD), and the Tang Dynasty (618-907).

## **SHANGHAI**

Bund / Yuyuan Garden / Shanghai Old Street / Former French Concession District / Shanghai Arts and Crafts Store / Xin Tian Di.

Start the tour with a visit to the Yuyuan Garden, a classic creation of the Ming Dynasty, and Shanghai Old Street, which had its origins in the Qing Dynasty. You will then stop at the Bund, Shanghai's waterfront, well known for its grand display of colonial-era architecture. Here you'll enjoy the wonderful view of both sides of the **Huangpu River**, followed by a visit to the Shanghai Museum of Ancient Chinese Arts that boasts a collection of more than 120,000 rare and unique items in 21 categories, making it the most remarkable cultural institution in the city. After lunch, the tour will continue by driving through the former French Concession to the Shanghai Arts and Crafts Store, stopping by the Jade Buddha Temple with its priceless jade statues from Burma on the way. The last stop Xin Tian Di is a stylish nightlife district with many boutiques, pubs, and restaurants. You are free to have a couple of drinks at a venue of your choice, or head back to the hotel with the group.
